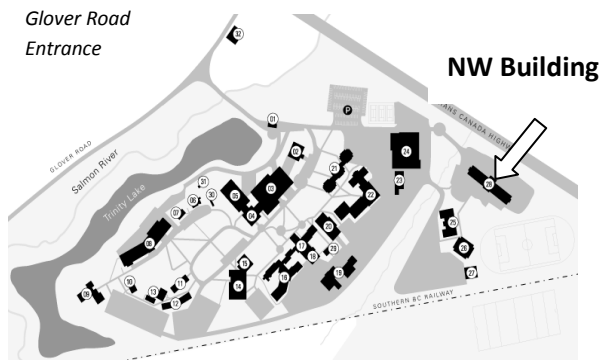

Dr. Camille Bishop has been involved in education for thirty years, beginning her career in the trenches as a secondary school mathematics instructor in the North Carolina public school system. Since 1988, she has been on the faculty of the University of the Nations, an educational ministry of Youth With A Mission (YWAM). Camille has led educational and development projects in Albania, Eastern Europe and Guinea-Bissau, West Africa and served as Associate Dean for the College of Education. She teaches a variety of courses with a focus on community development, leadership studies, multicultural education, and leadership transition. Dr. Bishop works with the U of N Provost, responsible for faculty development and curriculum oversight. She is an Adjunct Professor at several other Christian universities.

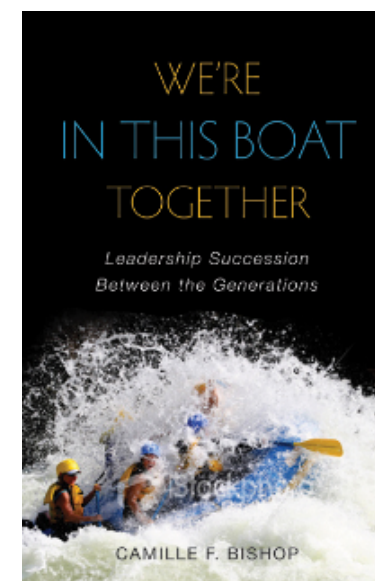

BOOK REVIEW:

The transfer of power within an organization is rarely easy; however, in light of the looming economic crisis, many organizations have been forced to make difficult decisions regarding personnel. The stakes have never been higher, as the face of leadership is changing across North America. This book presents a timely study on generational traits and should be required reading for all levels of leadership.

"As diversity in the workplace increases, evidence indicates that there *are* differences in leadership behaviour between the generations. And those dissimilarities create turbulence in the workplace like that found in white-water rapids," Dr. Bishop points out. "But there is a way to navigate through them! We're in this boat together, and diversity doesn't have to mean disaster. In fact, appreciating diversity and learning the skills necessary to dialogue with one another can bring the generations together, allowing for tremendous unity and strength to tackle the white-water of leadership succession."

This book was written to help all types of organizations to benefit from a greater understanding of leadership succession and a framework for dealing with change. ***We're in This Boat Together*** draws on three years of research and on Dr. Bishop's perspective as a leader in transition.
