What is Missions Fest?

Missions Fest has served the church by acting as a catalyst for mission for 35 years. We help people discover how their unique skills, gifts, knowledge and bodies can be used to bring God's redemption and reconciliation, flourishing and fullness (Shalom) to creation in every season of their lives. What is a Missions Fest “Partner Church”?

Identifies with the purposes of Missions Fest as stated in the Policies of Missions Fest* and agrees with the Statement of Faith* that is adopted by Missions Fest.

Understands that the defining marks of a Partner Church are the following:

1. Agrees to appoint one or two official representatives (maximum of two) who:
 - a) will serve as the liaison between our church and Missions Fest
 - b) will be appointed to be a voting member of the Missions Fest Society, whose responsibility it will be to attend the AGM and extraordinary general meetings*
 - c) may assist in planning the next Festival by joining a Working Team. (6/year – 2 x Sept, Oct, Nov, Jan, Feb)
 - d) will help recruit volunteers needed to facilitate the festival.
 - e) will help advertise Missions Fest events in our church
2. Agrees to mark the weekend of Missions Fest 2020 (**Jan. 31 – Feb 1, 2020**) on our church calendar and invite our people to attend by making pulpit announcements and by distribution of publicity materials.
3. Agrees to make a financial donation to Missions Fest to assist with the preparations of the coming festival. (A guideline is \$3.00 - \$ 4.00 per person based on the church’s average attendance.)

Note: According to the Society’s Constitution a member who misses the AGM and does not provide a reason will be removed from membership. This is not the same as the representative being removed or the church losing its role as a partner church. A written request from the church’s pastor should be made to have the member re-enrolled.

MISSIONS FEST POLICIES

Definition of Missions:

We define mission as a work of God, a work we are invited into, to redeem and reconcile all creation to God and bring flourishing and fullness (Shalom) to the earth.

Missions Fest Purposes:

1. To inform Christians of their responsibility in sharing the good news of Christ in word and deed.
2. To challenge Christians to go and get involved in sharing the good news of Christ.
3. To celebrate what our missional God is doing in the world.

Missions Fest includes a broad spectrum of Christian denominations and organizations. Care is taken to ensure that one organization, denomination or movement is not given excessive exposure. The emphasis is on glorifying and honouring Jesus.

The Missions Fest Management Team:

- **Members:** are Official Representatives appointed by each Partner (Sponsoring) Church. A maximum of two can be appointed. Representatives when approved by the Missions Fest Board of Directors are members of the Missions Festival (Missions Fest) Society and may vote on matters of policy. The Member is expected to attend the AGM, act as a liaison between Missions Fest and the Church, recruit volunteers and keep the church leadership informed about Missions Fest and Missions Fest events. If a member does not attend the AGM without notice his/her membership will be withdrawn.
- **The Board of Directors.** The Management Team will elect from among its membership, Directors consisting of: Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary and Members-at-large. Not more than one Director per congregation is allowed to fill this role. The Board is responsible to the Members for their decisions and actions. Board members are chosen from among representatives who have served at least one year. The term of office for each Board member is two years. A board member who has served for six consecutive years shall not be considered eligible for re-election for a period of one year. In order to provide continuity, approximately one-half of the officers will be elected each year.
- **The Nominating Committee** consists of two Board members who are not eligible for re-election in the current year, and three members of the Society who are not Board members. A new non-board member is elected each year to the nominating committee and serves a three year term. The chairman of the committee selected from among the committee.
- **Working Teams** are teams of volunteers who form a committee which is responsible for the operation and organization of an area of the conference. There are approximately 20 areas the working teams are responsible for. The members of a working team can be from non-partner churches. Representatives from Christian organizations may sit in on planning meetings as resource people. These teams meet twice in September, and once in October, November, January, and February to plan and implement the program each year. Normally, the third Thursday evening has been designated for the meetings. New members for these committees are brought on-board in September.
- **Registration:** Because Missions Fest is designed for the entire family, and because we do not wish anyone to be prevented from coming, no general registration fee will be charged.
- **Funding:** The four main sources of funding are:
 1. Donations from the Partner (Sponsoring) Churches
 2. Space rental from the organizations that have an exhibit
 3. Ticket sales for the Youth event and concerts.
 4. Donations made by individuals and received during the conference or mailed during the year.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

Mission Fest includes a broad spectrum of Christian denominations and organizations. Care will be taken to ensure that no one organization, denomination or movement is given excessive exposure. The emphasis will be on serving the church of Christ and on glorifying and honouring our Lord.

We believe...

1. That there is only One God, eternally existent in Three Persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit;
2. In the divine inspiration of Holy Scriptures, both the Old and New Testaments, and its consequent entire trustworthiness and supreme authority in all matters of faith and conduct;
3. In the universal sinfulness and guilt of human nature since the fall, making man subject to God's wrath and everlasting damnation;
4. In the substitutionary sacrifice of the incarnate Son of God as the sole ground for redemption from the guilt, penalty and power of sin;
5. In the justification of the sinner by the grace of God through faith alone in Christ crucified and risen from the dead.
6. In the illuminating, regenerating, indwelling and sanctifying work of God, the Holy Spirit, in the believer;
7. In the unity and common priesthood of all true believers, who together form the one universal Church, the Body of which Christ is the Head;
8. In the expectation of the personal, visible return of the Lord Jesus Christ
9. In the mandate to go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything that is commanded.

We, as a church, wholeheartedly agree with and endorse the Missions Fest Statement of Faith as stated above.

Job Description

Instructions

5. Then have these forms signed by the pastor of the church.
6. Attach the membership applications to the Church Registration/Renewal form.
